- All GB activities are in compliance with regulatory and Company requirements.

- Periodic hazard identification, assessment, control and review of the risks to the health and safety of all employees, and the public, arising from our activities.
- Continuous improvement in health and safety including hazardous substance control and pro-active housekeeping.
- Attention to the design and development of manufacturing processes, new and existing buildings, plant and products that minimise health and safety risk.
- Contractors and visitors have the necessary certification / documentation to ensure compliance with our policy and procedures.
- All dangerous occurrences, injuries, and occupational ill health are investigated and corrective action put in place.

To achieve this policy the company has defined an Occupational Health and Safety Management system and will provide education, training and appropriate resources to ensure all employees have sufficient knowledge, understanding and awareness to carry out their work safely.

The management system ensures that health and safety is a line management responsibility of the highest importance and is integrated into business activities. The system defines clear objectives and targets and will be examined through an annual audit plan, reviewed by Senior Management thus ensuring alignment with on-going arrangements and activities.

Progress in these requirements will be directed and reviewed throughout the organisation and key activities communicated.
